(1) Digitizing books held by the NDL


- •Most of the books published in the Meiji era (1868 ~1912) is to provide in this fiscal year 2005
- The books published in the Taisho era (1912 ~ 1926)

(2) Acquiring Internet information

Legislation for acquisition and providing Internet information generated inside Japan is now under scrutiny.

- 1 Acquiring web information by website
 - Bulk acquisition
 - Selective acquisition by theme
- 2 Acquiring web information by the unit of work
 - Online deposit
