

3-3E Let's access electronic journals

Electronic journals (e-Journals) are magazines available online. The "Electronic Journal and E-Book Title Search" allows you to:

- Search for both Journals that Nagoya University subscribed, and some open access journals
- Access links to full-text articles (note that some subscribed titles may be campus access only).
- Search by journal title (searching by article title or keyword is not supported).

Printed versions of journals cannot be searched via the Electronic Journal Access Service. Please use the Nagoya University Library Catalog (OPAC) instead. (Guidesheet2-2 Search for journals in Nagoya

University)

<How to Access and Search for e-Journals >

- Open Nagoya University Library website
- In Quick Links select "Search Books and Journals" or "Search Articles", select "e-Journals"
- 3. After opening Nagoya University electronic Journal Database, select the tab and search.

<Search Menu>

- Search by Title: Search by journal name, book title, or newspaper name.
- B. Search by Provider: Search by platform.
- Search by Subject: Narrow down your search by selecting a subject area.
- D. Browse Publications by Name: Search by the first letter(s) of the journal name (for alphabetic titles, select the first and second letters).

<How to search>

- In the Title Search tab, enter your search term in the search box and click the [Search] button.
 A list of matching results will be displayed.
- To access the material, click on the provider name listed under the Full-Text Access column (be sure to check the available years for access).

B. Available: The year, and volume number of the available journal in Nagoya University will be displayed.

Not all of the published volumes may be used, so make sure to check before selecting.




"2002-10-01-2021-06-01" \rightarrow Issues from October 2002 to June 2021 are available.

C. Links to Providers:These links direct you to the publisher or platform hosting the journal.

If multiple providers are available, multiple links will be displayed.

Before using any literature, please be sure to check the "Copyright and Fair Use".

The "Copyright and Fair Use" can be found on the "Database" page, which is accessible from the top page of Nagoya University Library.

The electronic journals contracted by Nagoya University are subject to license agreements between the providers and the university. If a violation of these agreements occurs, even if committed by an individual, access to the electronic journals may be suspended for the entire university. The same applies to openly accessible electronic journals.

[Request for Fair Use] Please adhere to the "Copyright and Fair Use"

- There have been cases where unintended actions were deemed excessive downloads beyond personal use, resulting in access suspension.
 - Examples: Automated data collection using programs, Browser preloading features, Continuous manual downloading
- Downloading from pirate sites (such as Sci-Hub) constitutes a violation of copyright law.
- Please refrain from mass downloading of data.

<Searching e-Journals in OPAC>

When you search a journal in OPAC, and 'Body Listing' is shown in 'Bibliography details', both the electronic version and printed version of the journal are available. XIn OPAC you cannot search journals, which are available only in electronic version.
